CONDITIONS

1. It is the policy of the Chand Bagh Foundation to keep the School Fees as low as possible. However, the Fees may be increased without prior notice.
2. Annual Fee covers the expenses on account of tuition, boarding, food, games and other on campus activities.
3. Annual Fee does not cover the cost of uniform, books, stationery, pocket money, laundry, haircut, out of campus activities and medical facilities.

4. Extra charges may be made as appropriate to cover the cost of optional expeditions, adventure training and certain other extra-curricular and co-curricular activities.
5. All Examination Fees are charged to the Parents / Guardians Account.
6. Term fee once deposited will not be refunded.
7. Parents / Guardians are urged to obtain medical / hospitalization insurance coverage for their boys.
8. A late fee fine at the rate of Rs. 200/- per day will be charged if the Fees are not paid within the due date.
9. If dues alongwith late fee fine are not paid within two weeks of the expiry of due date, the name of the boy shall be struck off the rolls. However, the boy will remain eligible to apply for readmission as per School rules.
10. Once registered, a boy's admission will depend upon his performance in the School's entrance tests together with a certificate of good conduct from his previous educational institution
